 - a. Jacob City/Soldier Canyon flooding events
 - i. September 20th event the channel had been inundated with mud and debris and caused the water to overflow.
 - b. Hydrocarbon Spill(s)
 - i. Flying J Truck Stop- 100+ gallons of fuel were spilled about 30 feet away from the storm drain. The response involved reclaiming the fuel from the storm drain.
 - ii. Pole Canyon Road head on collision that caused a diesel fuel spill on the asphalt. Envirocare came to take care of it.
- 6. **Update:** Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day: September 10th at clean harbors facility
 - a. The collection day event was successful. There has not been any E waste collection for a couple years which greatly reduced the traffic. Thanks to Search and Rescue for traffic control and thanks to EOC for electronic signage.
- 7. Update: EPA project in Stockton to reclaim/remediate lead and arsenic contaminated soils
 - a. On Silver Ave there was a historic smelter where ore and soil were processed and left. There has not been any funding for the project. Funding became available and the EPA worked to get that site cleaned up.
- 8. **Update**: Flood Restoration/Recovery Project in Soldier Canyon/Stockton area.
 - a. The county will be starting a multimillion-dollar restoration project in that area. A contract has been signed between the county and the NRCS. There will be retention bases as well as seeding

and controlling slopes. The restoration extends from Union Pacific Rail Line across SR 36 to the upper head of the canyon.
